taken over by

Boekestijn Transport Groep has taken over the activities of **Interlog** and **Vepotrans** previously based in Geldermalsen and Hoofddorp. With this take-over Boekestijn re-affirms its ambitions of stable growth to become a sizeable player in order to be able to adequately serve contractors both big and small.

On 15 September Interlog and Vepotrans were declared bankrupt by the Den Bosch district court. Over the course of the past few weeks Boekestijn has reached an agreement with the executor Stiekema, LLM concerning continuation of the activities. In close consultation with Interlog's and Vepotrans' former management the take-over will be integrated within the Boekestijn group as of now.

Boekestijn Transport Service and sister company R&W Fashion Transport are active across Europe with over 100 articulated units. Sensible. With both feet firmly on the ground. Transportation as it was meant to be. With our own staff.

In addition to fashion, pharma and food we also haul general cargo, from full-load to groupage.
